Details of which are as below:


- **Bangladesh:** Robbers usually target ships preparing to anchor. Most attacks reported at Chittagong and Cox's Bazar have fallen significantly over the past few years because of the efforts by the Bangladeshi authorities.
- **China:** Tianjin/Caofeidian - Incidents mostly at anchorage area.
- **India:** Sikka and Kandla: Incidents reported at port and anchorage areas.


